Footnotes

PEGASIAN rode the rail, was taken outward midway on the far turn, swung three wide into the stretch, moved past the leader by the three-sixteenths pole after receiving mild hand encouragement, then widened out during the final eighth under more extensive riding tactics. COPS FEVER set the pace along the inside and held well for the place. FORTISSI MORE saved ground, was swung to the outside heading for the stretch, had a mild rally to be along for the show. WESTERN CONNECTION pressed the pace until upper stretch and weakened. HOIST THE GALA raced along the outside and lacked a rally. MARRA MARRA steadied leaving the chute, was eased to the three path during the run down the backstretch, failed to reach a contending position. MR. HOOKER well off the inside, bore out a bit during the run around the bend while racing greenly, got his act back together in time to outfinish weakening rivals during the stretch drive. FOURTEEN AND OUT was never in the hunt. THUNDERIN OTIS rated off the pacesetter three wide under a good hold, had no response after being called upon. COALTOWN LEGEND underwent a four wide journey and faded after going three quarters.
