STORMIN NORMANDY away quickly from the starting gate, outsprinted the field to grab the early lead, set swift fractions while racing in the two path, responded well when roused in upper stretch, then held held sway despite drifting out in the late stages. ROLLERS chased the winner throughout while three wide and dug in to preserve the place. FEROCIOUS FIRES raced along the outside and came home with good energy. MEGAPIXEL tracked the leader while saving ground, was forced to await racing room after entering the lane, angled outward in the vicinity of the eighth pole for clearance, proceeded to get outkicked for the show. GOOD CARD was no factor. GOLD AND ROSES had no rally. MR. WINDJAMMER bumped at the start, never reached a contending position. JOHNIE BYE NIGHT was bumped after stumbling at the start, failed to menace. PRINCE OF PEACE was never in the hunt. IRISH BLAST underwent a four wide journey and gave way after going a half. LAW ENFORCEMENT was through after a half.
