Footnotes

LOGIC WAY patiently stalked the pacesetter from the three path until turning for home, responded positively when given his cue in upper stretch, advanced gradually towards the front, drew on even terms with the leaders at the sixteenth pole and prevailed in the final strides. GET SERIOUS took command soon after the start, showed the way along the inside on an open lead, was tested approaching the head of the stretch, dug in with determination to preserve his lead, came in slightly in deep stretch, bumping with his entymate, then continued on gamely to the wire. HANGINGBYATHREAD accompanied the pacesetter from the outside for six furlongs, ranged up to that one to draw alongside at the furlong marker, battled gamely but came up short. BANROCK finished with good energy outside. CLASSIC PACK saved ground until swinging outward nearing the quarter pole, came home with a good rally. NORTH COUNTRY took the inside route, angled off the rail as the field approached the top of the lane, was in the midst of a good move when forced to steady

behind traffic, then lacked the needed racing room throughout the final furlong. GIMME CREDIT saved ground, waited momentarily for room turning for home, advanced into contention along the path abandoned by NORTH COUNTRY in upper stretch, attempted to squeeze by the leader along the inside in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, was bumped by that rival and steadied, losing all chance. AL BASHA raced along the outside and tired. SOLVENT was no factor. MY MAN LARS lacked a rally. SELF MADE MAN raced four wide on both turns. STEPASIDE offered little.
