Footnotes

CANDY RAIDER advanced along the rail during the initial stages to take up residence in the pocket, tracked the front runners while sitting there until late on the turn, had sufficient clearance and slipped into the two path in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, waited a little while longer then was set down, responded positively and was driven to the front running through the furlong grounds, dug in well in the last eighth under strong handling to preserve the advantage. SECURITY ANALYSIS raced from between rivals, having been to early encouragement during the run around the bend, swung outward into the four path for the start of the stretch drive, continued on willingly down the lane for place honors. MISTER WOOLMAN stumbled awkwardly at the break, went on to secure a forward position, put some pressure on the early pacesetter from the outside for almost a half, moved when ready, with ACT OF DIVINITY likewise doing so but one path further to the outside coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was successful in taking over, came under attack from the winner by upper stretch, relinquished before reaching the eighth pole and steadily weakened. ARMOR three wide, was asked to pick it up by midpoint on the turn but failed to answer the call. PERFECT SUNDAY got off two beats slowly, raced as the trailer while taking the inside route until upper stretch, shied outward several lanes at a time from the first of interspersed left handed shots during the initial portion of the stretch drive, minded his manners thereafter en route to improving position. ACT OF DIVINITY issued a challenge from the three path late on the turn, gave way after entering the stretch. CAPTAIN EASY led the field down the backstretch while placed in the two path, tucked closer over to the rail at the half mile pole, was put to a stern test leaving the midway point, yielded without putting up much resistance and retreated.
