DECLAN'S WARRIOR settled early on at the rear just off the inside, saved ground throughout coming under urging at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch, offered up a good kick through the stretch riding the rail the whole way to get up in the final strides and prevail. QUINBY PETE prompted the pace three wide, got set down at the three-sixteenths inching away from the rest in tandem with NATIONAL PRAYER to the furlong grounds, seized command a furlong out, dug in all out under a drive getting displaced in the final strides and forced to settle for the place honors. ITHASTOBEGEORGE tracked the pace along the inside coming under prolonged urging from the half mile pole, swung four wide for home, offered up late energy for the show honors. NATIONAL PRAYER reluctant to load, set a prompted pace from the two path, got set down at the quarter pole, inched away in concert with QUINBY PETE from the rest of the field to the eighth pole, got displaced at that station, stayed on until weakening in the final sixteenth while holding for the last major share. IN THE DARK coaxed along just off the inside towards the rear, got asked at the three-eighths pole, spun six wide in upper stretch, made mild late gain while making no impact. ACCLAIM bumped lightly at the start when BROTHER BOB broke in, came under hustling to chase three wide in the turn, offered up a mild bid to upper stretch when cornering five wide at that juncture, flattened out late on. BROTHER BOB broke in at the start bumping lightly with ACCLAIM before being corrected, raced four to five wide through the turn towards the rear, was asked at the five-sixteenths and offered no kick. BELLARDO broke out at the start, chased four wide from close range, swung six to seven wide at the top of the stretch and tired.
