RAQUEL sat parked out three wide under a good hold for the opening half, was asked for run soon afterwards until put to a drive turning for home, closed the gap readily on the pacesetter during the run through the furlong grounds, collared that rival in the final seventy yards, then dug in well to fend off the runner up, kept to a strong drive. COAST OF SANGRIA got knocked into making contact with GRANBY GIRL after being bumped by SO MUCH HEART a couple of jumps out of the starting gate, raced well reserved at or near the back off the pack for the initial half, began to pick up interest approaching the quarter pole, was fanned outward until four wide by the three-sixteenths pole, came home with good energy down the center of the strip to garner the place. IRISH WEDDING broke to the outside, was grabbed hold of but not in time to prevent her from making contact with GOLD LOVE, went on to assume the front, showed the way while racing towards the inside, with GALAXY JET attending her one path to the outside, responded positively when given her cue entering the stretch, was still in possession of a comfortable advantage with an eighth to go, but with the top twosome displaying enough foot to loom dangers, had one of them go by leaving the sixteenth pole, with the other one following suit in short order to wrest away the place. MALIBU HOLIDAY within range off the inside, was under strong handling coming three wide into the stretch, lacked the necessary response. GRANBY GIRL got bumped after the start, departed the backstretch from the three path, latched on to the leader for a few strides in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole before flattening out. GOLD LOVE was bumped at the start, took the inside route, cut the corner having already been put to hand urging, angled outward into the three path during the initial portion of the stretch run, came up empty. SO MUCH HEART came inward leaving the starting gate, bumping with the nearest opponent,

raced from off the inside, got put to a prolonged drive, made no headway on the front runners. GALAXY JET coaxed along prompting the pacesetter from the outside for a half, folded. MONTICELLO DOLL squeezed back after the start, darted over to the inside, rode the rail until upper stretch, never reached a contending position.
