**Footnotes**

ZULTANITE bumped at the start, went to secure the pocket, tracked the front runners from there being rated along, eased outward just before the commencement of the stretch drive, kicked in with good energy when asked for a response, arrived at the eighth pole full of run, overhauled ANTONIA AUTUMN a short distance past the furlong grounds and edged away under good handling. SEANCHAI raced three wide around both turns, was asked for a response at the five-sixteenths marker, came home willingly to garner the place. ANTONIA AUTUMN contently stalked the leader from the outside, issued a challenge leaving the midway point on the far turn, grabbed a narrow advantage, was still clutching to it by the end of the run through the furlong grounds, but with the winner lurking a serious threat, yielded to that rival's pressure and weakened enough late to miss out on second as well. DOUBLE BERG brought up the rear for the nearly six furlongs, was already under solid encouragement taking the two path for entrance into the lane, split rivals in upper stretch and rallied to earn the final major check. STAR TORINA cut the pace from inside, came under heavy pressure late on the far turn and was soon let out in response to the challenge, relinquished to the challenger, remained a prominent factor until midstretch before backing away. ISLAND SCHOOL bumped between opponents at the break, moved into contention with a four wide run on the far turn, fanned from well off the inside turning for home, flattened out. CHRISTINA D'ORO lightly bumped at the start, raced from off the inside and failed to muster up a solid closing punch. FIRE ASSAY placed five wide at the head of the stretch, proved to be empty. HOLIDAY'S JEWEL raced along the outside and was through after going three-quarters.
