Footnotes

HEIR TO DARE ducked in coming out of the starting gate, sparred briefly with QUEEN MERCURY before putting that opponent away by the end of the backstretch, steadily extended the advantage racing around the bend, got set down a couple of jumps prior to the quarter pole, drew off, getting geared down to light hand encouragement in the very late stages. MERRYLAND MOON off a beat slowly, travelled two wide for the majority of the way on the turn, was driven into the four path turning for home, drifted out a bit more shortly afterwards, rallied to get the place. QUEEN MERCURY contended for the lead with the winner briefly down the backstretch, chased that opponent from just off the inside afterwards, swung into the lane and was outfinished for second. VINDA chased the winner from the two path, gave way. GAMBLING GERALDINE raced along the outside and was outrun. MISS LIBBY lunged at the start, commenced the stretch five wide with little to offer.
