ELLIE'S MOMENT was outrun early, advanced inside on the turn, swung wide entering the stretch, finished gamely from the outside and got up late, driving. SHINY BAND raced close up inside while in hand and finished gamely on the rail. RESEMBLANCE contested the pace while three wide, earned a short lead in midstretch and continued on gamely to the wire. CHASM was bumped at the start and outrun early, rallied nearing the stretch and finished well while between rivals. MAGICAL MASQUERADE contested the pace along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. LOVE N' KISS S. was bumped at the start and crowded between rivals then was bumped nearing the turn, was steadied and raced greenly while outside. LATOUR put in a four wide run approaching the stretch and tired in the drive. DRIFT ALONG contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. DIVERSITY was bumped at the half mile pole, raced wide and tired.
