BEAUTIFUL AMERICA broke a bit awkwardly, dropped back early, rallied four wide on the turn, dug in gamely in the stretch and prevailed under a drive. COMBANCHERA raced close up early, advanced three wide on the turn, reached the front entering the stretch and fought it out gamely to the finish. SHESASMOKIN was outrun early, put in a three wide run on the turn and lacked a solid finishing kick. BLINK TWICE contested the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. BEHRNIK was hustled along early but had no response when roused. DOC'S DOLL tired after showing brief speed. ORMSBYS TREASURE quickly showed in front, contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. SCARLET BILLOWS chased the pace along the inside and was finished early. ROCKIN RACHEL ANNE stumbled at the start and tired.
