ROYAL SPAULDING was rated along early, rallied three wide approaching the stretch, responded when roused and drew away late, driving. NAUTICAL AGENT was outrun early, advanced inside on the turn, came wide for the drive and rallied to get the place prize. GILDED THREAD chased the pace while three wide and weakened in the final furlong. WITH AFFIRMATION contested the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. FAIR MAIDEN chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. TUSCAN STAR was steadied after the start and had no rally. SWEET COLORS showed speed along the inside and tired after a half mile. CHEEKTOWAGA was outrun along the inside. DERIVATIVE TRADER contested the pace along the inside and tired. LONESOME DAY raced inside and tired.
