ELDER SKATESMAN raced close up early, rallied three wide and dug in while between rivals in the stretch. CHOSEN APTITUDE was outrun early, raced wide and offered a mild rally outside. TAKEMYWIFE PLEASE was outrun early, raced inside and was going well late. DISTINCTIVE SANDY raced wide and had no response when roused. GOLD PAGEANTRY had no rally. NEW YORK MOON chased the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. KINGS COMMOTION was hustled out to a clear lead, set the pace and tired in the stretch. GENERAL CONGRESS chased the pace along the inside and tired. REAL BULL raced inside and tired.
