Footnotes

ORSONIAN took up position in midpack, was put to encouragement from the two path to keep pace during the run around the bend, altered course by angling outward sharply four wide in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, and continued his pursuit, found his best stride departing the eighth pole, cruised by the leader in deep stretch, crossing the wire hand roused. ULTIMO PRINCIPE grabbed the front soon after the start, was coaxed along while showing the way from the inside, felt intensified pressure approaching the quarter pole and was let out in response, offered good resistance before yielding reluctantly just prior to the wire. BLACK N BEAUTY was hustled along right from the get-go chasing the leader from off the inside, brushed with DAVID THE GREAT as that pair spun into the lane, came home willingly to earn the show award. DAVID THE GREAT underwent a three wide pursuit, bumped lightly with BLACK N BEAUTY while making a run from there at the pacesetter, kept up the pressure for an additional furlong before flattening out. EXPECTING CASH vacated the inside route to slip past a tiring rival midway on the turn, swung four wide into upper stretch and rallied mildly. SENSATIONAL SLAM strung out in the four path at the three-eighths pole, folded. WAR COLONY was taken to the rail at the nine-sixteenths pole, saved ground thereafter and faded.
