HYMN BOOK allowed to settle unhurried at the rear, progressed on the front under his own power from the three-eighths pole to be on even terms swinging from the six path for home, overhauled the front nearing the three-sixteenths under the mildest of hand urging, widened clear to the sixteenth pole, was geared down from there to the wire to prevail comfortably. SMALL TOWN TALK came in slightly after the start bumping lightly with RULE, was out in the five path down the backside in close range of the pace, remained unhurried four wide through the turn until put to coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun five wide in upper stretch fully engaged by the rider, was overwhelmed in tandem with RULE at that juncture proving no match for the aforementioned rival while drawing clear of the rest for the place honors. RULE broke in at the start bumping XIN XU LIN, then was bumped lightly by SMALL TOWN TALK shortly after, prompted the pace while four wide down the backside, remained with one path in between him and his main pace foe through the turn, took command at the five-sixteenths as the pressure began to intensify, was roused at the quarter pole spinning four wide, inhaled by top one nearing the three-sixteenths and folded. XIN XU LIN (BRZ) bumped at the start when RULE broke inwards, set a solid pace while in reserve from just off the inside, the sole member of the field to be within three paths of the rail, got displaced nearing the five-sixteenths and gave way.
