BIG GRANDPA quickly established control, cut the pace, well rated in the two path and without having to face any real resistance, was a short way into the stretch drive before being asked for a response himself, drew well clear of the others, crossing the wire under brisk encouragement. SINAI chased the winner three wide on the turn, proved no match but finished willingly to be well clear for place honors. HE'S SO CHIC tossed his head up and down and subsequently got off slowly, failed to get motivated after a short series of shots near the right shoulder, did begin to pick up the pace coming to the end of the backstretch, swung five wide into the stretch and rallied down the outside of the track to be along for the show. YA GOTTA HAVE SOUL unhurried and under a good hold from the pilot towards the two path until the quarter pole, failed to muster up a solid closing punch when finally asked for a response, drifted over to the rail during the initial portion of the stretch run and tired. MANAGED ACCOUNT near the two path and under a full drive by the midway point on the turn, got angled outward sharply from the five-sixteenths marker, had no rally. LISTON faded off a ground-saving journey. ANDERSONSTATE three to four wide on the turn, folded.
