Footnotes

STOCK FUND tracked the front runners while being rated in the pocket, was forced to remain on hold bidding time while lacking suitable options from the five-sixteenths pole to the end of the bend, found room to maneuver to the outside, angling three wide for the commencement of the stretch, responded when given her cue, charged up towards the leader to arrive at the eighth pole only the barest of margins behind, quickly took over and edged away, driving. ROYAL JEST broke alertly and sat forwardly placed throughout, was kept on hold prompting the leader from the outside, got set down for drive home and took over, clung desperately to a sliver of an advantage with an eighth to go and with the winner bearing down hard to the outside looking at her eye to eye, yielded shortly afterwards, continued onward in a willing manner for the place. ROCK N COZY was bumped by THREECRACKERCHILE a few jumps after coming out of the starting gate, alternated between the inside route and two path until the quarter pole, went on to cut the corner into the lane, failed to keep pace with the two twosome in the final furlong, showed enough though to secure the show. PIE'S FIRST LADY along the rail for much of the way down the backstretch, was primarily in the two path around the turn, arrived at its end having already been roused, swung outward, entering the stretch to be five wide

by the three-sixteenths pole, mustered up a mild response the rest of the way home to take the last major check. ECHLUATH well off the rail throughout, fanned wider and wider travelling through the furlong grounds until about eight wide, the widest of all with an eighth to go, rallied well only to have to settle for minor spoils. JENNYS CREEK raced along the outside, was asked for run prior to the quarter pole, got placed seven wide in upper stretch, flattened out. LIVE LIFE FAST underwent a three wide on the turn, folded. ROSALIE'S PLEASURE lightly hand urged, cut the pace from the inside, relinquished to the runner up and tired. CAKE N COOKIES got shuffled back midway on the turn while taking the inside route, launched a run afterwards to make up the lost ground and position, had little left for the last eighth and backed away. LLOYD HARBOR three wide at the five-sixteenths marker, had no rally. GLORIA VICTORIA raced three to four wide on the turn, came wider into the stretch and gave way. THREECRACKERCHILE lunged outward, was immediately pulled back towards the inside with force by the pilot and bumped with ROCK N COZY right afterwards, took the four path around the turn and tired.
