STARTING ALLY chased the pace along the rail and finished well. PRO MOTION DAYS, outrun early, finished well. GALLANT NUMBER chased the pace, came wide for the drive and lacked a rally. KERRY OFFALY lacked a rally. KIPPERELLA contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. LADY BLUMSTIR raced four wide and had no rally. GATE AGARBO raced very wide throughout. MARITIME BRASS contested the pace along the inside and tired after a half mile. RAINY SUNDAY tired after showing brief speed. LADIES GALORE raced five wide and tired.
