DR. V'S MAGIC stumbled at the start, raced in hand early, came wide nearing the stretch, responded when roused, dug in outside and prevailed under a drive. WHO WHAT WIN raced close up early while in hand, split rivals entering the stretch and dug in gamely inside in the drive. RUN RED RUN raced with the pace from the outside, led between calls in upper stretch and tired in the final furlong. NAUGHTY NEW YORKER was bumped after the start, was pinched back, was steadied, raced wide, lugged in in the stretch and lacked a rally. LORD LANGFUHR was bumped after the start, raced inside and had no response when roused. INDIAN HAWKE lunged into the gate at the start, was bumped then chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. STORM BOOT GOLD broke awkwardly, bobbed, was hustled to the front, set the pace for three quarters and tired. BUILDING NEW ERA was bumped after the start, raced wide throughout and had no rally. FRENCH TRANSITION was outrun along the inside.
