### Footnotes

METROLOGY assumed a forward position soon after the start, sat on hold perched three wide during the initial stages, picked up the pace upon reaching the turn, followed ALL IN NO OUT's lead, challenging as the widest of the three front runners, worked his way to the front to grab a slim advantage with an eighth to go, but with the runner up latched on his hind quarters and in hot pursuit, dug in with good determination during the final furlong to fend off the solo stretch threat. GLACIER BAY contently tracked the pacesetter while taking the inside route, angled outward leaving the five-sixteenths pole, briefly drafted behind the top one before tipping a bit wider after settling into upper stretch, reached the furlong marker lurking as a danger from directly behind the eventual winner, continued onward but failed to gain any additional ground. EVER A FRIEND unhurried early, was under encouragement spinning from the four path into the stretch, lacked the needed response. ALL IN NO OUTS patiently prompted the pacesetter from the outside for the opening half, crept up to apply more pressure by the five-sixteenths pole, sustained the momentum to strike the front as the field headed into the stretch, offered some resistance before yielding to the top one, then steadily weakened. AMERICAN CLASSIC stalked from off the inside, was driven five wide into the lane, had no rally. W. W.'S LADY'S MAN established control quickly after leaving the starting gate, was rated along the inside cutting the opening splits, felt pressure during the later stages of the run around the bend, got displaced before making it to the eighth pole, faded during the final furlong. SHOW TRIAL raced along the outside and trailed.
