Footnotes

WILLET off the inside, was put to brisk hand urging and asked to pick up the pace in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, angled sharply four wide for the commencement of the stretch drive, grabbed command before reaching the end of the furlong grounds, drew off decisively thereafter, crossing the finish line under a very strong hand drive. MISS VALENTINE took the inside route, was under some hand encouragement cutting the corner into the stretch, altered course several lanes towards the outside in midstretch, closed in on the front runners battling at this stage for second honors, split a pair of them and grabbed the coveted place award. LADY ON THE RUN outrun for a half, finished well belatedly for the show. BEAUTIFUL BUT BLUE chased three wide and got outfinished for second. RISKY RACHEL dueled three wide with AGAVE KISS, remained a prominent factor until midlane before backing away. GREAT GRACIE DANE along the rail down the backstretch, chose the two path as the way to go around the turn, tracked the duelers from afar, narrowed in late on the turn, then flattened out. AGAVE KISS argued for control from off the inside, the pilot atop with a firm grip on the reins for nearly a half, was still hooked up with RISKY RACHAEL for the start of the stretch run, got shaken off soon afterwards for good and faltered. GUYANA PRINCESS was outrun.
