The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Three year olds, 122 lbs. Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$40,000 since June 1, 2012 allowed 3 lbs.; a sweepstake in 2012, 5 lbs.; three races, 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in allowances). MINE OVER MATTER settled towards the rear just off the inside in the two path among a compact group, got set down three wide in upper stretch, rallied steadily gaining through to the furlong marker, took command nearing the sixteenth pole between rivals, inched away under a drive to prevail. SAGINAW broke out at the start bumping lightly with SMOKIN HERO before being taken off that rival, initially at the back, ranged up four wide in the early part of the turn to be among the leaders at the midway point, came under urging just past the five-sixteenths, was the outermost of a trio swinging heads apart for home, took command just past the three-sixteenths, dug in under a heavy near sided stick work, got displaced at the sixteenth marker running on willingly for the place honors. SHREWD ONE three wide in close range despite being towards the rear, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, swung four to five wide in upper stretch, offered up good energy through the lane but was out kicked by the top pair. SPORTSWRITER tracked the pace inside until able to shift off the rail at the five-sixteenths, lost some ground shifting out five wide at the quarter pole, kicked home belatedly for the last major share. NEATIE THE CAT broke open the gate prior to the start, prompted the pace early on of SMOKIN HERO before pressing DR DISCO through the latter portion of the turn, assumed a brief lead at the quarter pole when roused, led until displaced just past the three-sixteenths and weakened in the final furlong. DR DISCO three wide prompting the pace initially took over the front vacated by SMOKIN HERO nearing the three-eighths pole under pressure by NEATIE THE CAT inside, held the front to just prior to the quarter pole when roused between rivals, weakened in the stretch. GROUND FORCE hustled from the gate, chased three to four wide in the turn, came under urging midway and offered no response. SMOKIN HERO bumped at the start, showed brief speed under pressure while along the inside, got displaced near the three-eighths and steadily retreated.
