Footnotes

HESSONITE came way in good order, settled into the middle of the pack from off the inside, rated kindly in the two path for over three-quarters, got tipped into the three path coming to the quarter pole, bided time for a couple of jumps before going on through between rivals to take charge at the end of the furlong grounds, kicked clear, crossing the finish line under a very confident hand ride. SHAKEIRA raced well reserved along the outside for the initial six furlongs, was let out a notch and put in the four path at the five-sixteenths pole, in preparation for the stretch drive, failed to keep pace with the much the best winner during the last eighth, but rallied with enough determination to earn the place award. GITCHEE GOOMIE three wide at the three-eighths pole, rallied into contention by midstretch then flattened out. KIBOSH patiently stalked the front runners from off the rail, availed of the opportunity when one member of the vanguard drifted outward midpoint on the full turn and took up residence in the three path, waited a little further being getting asked for a response, was outfinished. MYSTIC CITY urged taking the two path for entrance into the stretch, lacked the needed response. DREAMING OF CARA slipped off the rail in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, had no rally. FREEDOM RINGS saved ground to no avail. WHOLELOTTASHAKIN disputed the pace two wide until the end of the backstretch, tucked over to the rail in time for the run around the far turn, kept up the fight until upper stretch and faltered. COLOR BLIND off a beat slowly, raced along the outside and was outrun. CONSIDERATE basically underwent a four wide journey for the opening six furlongs, drifted onto the overland route near the three-eighths pole, tired badly after entering the stretch. DIVADORA contested the pace three wide until the half mile pole, remained a pace factor for just over three-quarters before backing away. PRIZE DOLL in the four path at the three-eighths pole, tired.
