MATCHMADEINHEAVEN raced three wide for most of the way around the turn, picked up the pace fanning out for the stretch drive, settled into the six path at the top of the lane, unleashed a strong run after getting straightened away, collared the show horse in deep stretch, edged away, then had plenty of time and energy left to prevail. AGILION rode the rail, angled to be four wide by the three-sixteenths pole, having already asked for a response, closed in on KELLI GOT FROSTY in the final sixteenth from a slight distance behind the winner and went on to secure second. KELLI GOT FROSTY sat three wide off the contested pace, was called upon turning for home, drifted inward slightly in upper stretch, was between rivals gaining the advantage in midstretch, showed good determination with the top twosome in hot pursuit shortly afterward prior to relinquishing to the persistent pair in the final strides. ZEKES SURPRISE raced between rivals for a good portion of the way on the turn, commenced the stretch drive three wide, lacked the needed late foot. E STREET BOURBON assumed a forward position in the early stages, sparred from the outside with MY SMARTNESS for just over a half, gained no respite after having put that opponent away, getting locked in a tussle with KELLI GOT FROSTY immediately afterwards, yielded coming to the furlong marker, battled onward with the previously mentioned foe for an additional sixteenth before finally weakening from his earlier efforts. COPPER BLUFF outrun for the

opening half while racing from off the inside, rallied belatedly to mostly improve position. CARAMEAWAY stalked the embattled pair just up ahead, doing so from the two path and under a firm hold for nearly a half, responded positively when given his cue for the run through the furlong grounds, flattened out once past it. JULESCO underwent a four wide pursuit, stayed within range of the front runners until midlane before backing away. HEIDI'S HOLIDAY traversed along in the overland route and was outrun. ASCENDED FEVER stumbled badly at the start, was in the four path and set down at the five-sixteenths pole, offered no pick up in speed. MY SMARTNESS good hooked in a duel with E STREET BOURBON soon after the start, argued with that rival while taking the inside route until the five-sixteenths marker, fell back slightly before arriving at that station, then more readily afterwards. GEE LINZ tucked into the pocket coming to the half mile pole, tracked the front runners for just over a half before retreating.
