TALENT N PASSION broke sharply and cut the pace from just off the inside joined and pressured by a pair from the half mile pole through the turn, got let out at the quarter pole, inched away to the eighth pole, dug in a bit leg weary under challenge from that same pair, was guided out a path through the final sixteenth in a solid piece of race riding and just held on. SEASONED WARRIOR four wide in close aim of the front from the half mile pole, got set down three wide into upper stretch, rallied in tandem with LAGUNA GIRL to threaten the leader through the final sixteenth, got carried out as the aforementioned rival was driven out a path in the late stages forcing Laguna girl to lean on her in the final jumps and just missed. LAGUNA GIRL prompted the pace coaxed between foes from the three path through the turn, got set down nearing the quarter pole just off the inside, rallied between foes through the final sixteenth losing optimal clearance as TALENT N PASSION tightened the lane late forcing her to lean a bit on SEASONED WARRIOR and missed while well clear of the rest. MADRE DITUTTICAPI saved ground chasing from afar through the turn, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide for home and made no impact. CRY HOLY lost her footing at the start and recovered breaking inwards, was outrun early on, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun three to four wide at the quarter pole and offered no kick.
