HOLY ENDEAVOR in behind the pace just off the inside in a bit of tight quarters among foes, came under urging three furlongs out taking to the rail and shutting off SPIRIT OF PEACE in the process, forcing that foe to clip heels and check sharply at that station which in turn forced POLIZIANO to clip his heels and lose the rider, advanced steadily into contention swinging just off the inside for home, rallied inside and was angled out a path a furlong from home, split foes steadily gaining at the sixteenth pole, took over in the late stages and inched away under active urging. CROSS GATE forwardly placed three to four wide, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide for home, rallied to seize command briefly a sixteenth out, was collared in the final strides while garnering the place honors. ANTONE SUAVEY broke in at the start bumping and jostling POLIZIANO between foes, settled three to four wide in mid pack, got asked at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home and offered up a mild kick for the show. SOUTHERN SAFARI four to five wide in mid pack, came under urging four wide at the head of the stretch, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. CORYBANT on the pace in hand just off the inside, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into the stretch but took to the rail straightened away, dug in under

challenge from a trio a furlong out, got headed a sixteenth from the wire and weakened through the remainder of the stretch. PATRIOTIC DUTY saved ground early on towards the rear, showed adept reflexes swerving sharply to avoid the fallen rider at the three-eighths pole to nearly the outside fence, came under encouragement nearing the quarter pole cornering seven to eight wide and was ridden out through the stretch albeit after losing any chance midway. SCORPION BOY bumped at the start, settled just off the inside towards the rear, was briefly in hand around the fallen rider three furlongs out, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun five wide for home and offered no response. BANZAI KID broke in at the start bumping SCORPION BOY, prompted the pace three wide, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, remained a forward factor to the eighth pole before faltering in the final furlong. QUIET MIRACLE outrun in the early going, raced two to three wide to midway on the turn, cut the corner into the stretch and never threatened. SPIRIT OF PEACE tracked the pace inside in close aim of the front, jostled lightly with the eventual winner HOLY ENDEAVOR into the far turn, was checked sharply clipping the heels of that foe when impeded three furlongs out as that rival took to the rail, bobbed and was in turn clipped behind by POLIZIANO who lost the rider in the process, continued three wide into the lane under light coaxing and made no impact. POLIZIANO jostled between foes and squeezed a bit at the break, raced in a bit tight in aim early on and was eased back to mid pack at the half mile pole, raced just off the inside into the turn, had the impeded SPIRIT OF PEACE check in front and clipped the heels of the back of that foe at the three-eighths pole, bobbed and lost the rider as a result. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the incident midway on the turn before the result was declared official.
