BIOGIO'S ROSE was unhurried outside early on, raced wide throughout, closed determined from the outside in the stretch and was up in the final strides, driving. MISS THERMAL TECH showed good speed while in hand, contested the pace while three wide and dug in gamely through the stretch but could not withstand the winner. JENA JENA contested the pace along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. WINLOC'S GLORIOUS chased the pace while four wide and lacked a solid finishing kick. BROOMESSE was outrun along the inside early on, altered course to the outside in midstretch and finished well. EVENTAIL contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. SUPERNAL raced inside and had no rally. PATTY'S POSITIVE had no response when roused. SUSAN MCGRATH raced wide and tired. KAWAJLAIN tired after an inside trip.
