FOR TWO YEAR OLD. No nomination fee. A supplemental nomination fee of \$200 may be made at time of entry. \$1,000 to enter, starters to receive a \$750 rebate. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a race on the turf, allowed 3 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in allowances). A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Wednesday, October 17, 2007 with 29 nominations and 1 supplement. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the main track.)

CANNONBALL raced close up outside, drew clear into the stretch, dug in gamely along the inside and got the nod after a long drive. SUNDAYSUNDAY raced in hand early, rallied four wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely outside, just missing. MORAL COMPASS raced close up inside, came wide for the drive and was outfinished. REBOUNDED was outrun early, raced inside, rallied into the stretch and was going well late. WHY TONTO raced close up along the inside and had no response when roused. GRASBERG was outrun early, raced four wide throughout and offered a mild rally outside. FORT DRUM was steadied at the start, dropped back early and had no rally. CARRY THE DAY was outrun early, raced inside and was never in contention. YA THINK was outrun along the inside. HE AINT EASY raced inside and tired. HUSSONFIRST was finished after a half mile. PIQUANTE CAT was hustled to the front, set the pace and tired in the stretch.
