SONG OF BROADWAY was taken in hand leaving the starting gate, remained unhurried throughout the run down the backstretch, began to pick up the pace departing the half mile pole, motored up effortlessly towards the leader, initially four deep at the three-eighths pole, but much nearer the two path by the time she reached the quarter pole, cruised by ELIZA GRACE to take over, then drew away convincingly under a mild hand ride to the wire. ELIZA GRACE made the early lead on her own courage, easily discouraging a more energetically-handled opponent, showed the way under a good hold until the quarter pole, had no answer for the top one in upper stretch, yielding readily, but managed to preserve place honors under a stiff drive. ABOVE THE CALL bumped at the start, came four wide into the stretch and bested the rest. SISTER BERTA failed to menace. CRYSTAL GALOPOFF was bumped at the start and saved ground to no avail thereafter. GOLDA KARAKORUM bumped at the start, swung five wide into the stretch and had no offering. LIGHTNING DREAMS displayed brief foot. JEN'S DREAM hustled away from the gate, was outsprinted for the lead nonetheless, faded after entering the stretch.
