**Footnotes**

LAUREATE CONDUCTOR contently stalked the early pacesetter from a distance during the most of the way down the backstretch, gradually worked his way forward nearing the half mile pole, ranged up to make a bid a quarter of a mile later, responded positively when given his cue in upper stretch, left the furlong grounds holding a clear edge, then reached the finish line in time under a drive to preserve it. MYTHICAL HERO saved ground until the quarter pole, angled out into the two path just before reaching the head of the stretch, took off in earnest after being called upon, cut into the leader's margin with every stride during the final eighth, but ran out of ground. CAUSE OF FREEDOM within range outside, rallied with good energy to grab the show. LEMON CREAM PIE sped off from the competition, showed the way uncontested along the inside until the quarter pole, remained a pace factor before backing off during the last eighth. LEMON SPICE was off sluggishly after brushing the right side of the gate, sat reserved for over a half mile, attempted to reach a striking position with a four wide run around the far turn, but wasn't up to the task. PLEASANT STRIKE took the opening bend from the three path, exchanged a number of bumps with a hand to handle LIME RICKEY along the backstretch, continued to race wide and had no stretch offering. INDY SCENT unhurried for nearly a half, assumed the role of stalker, from the three path, departing the backstretch, was asked for some run to keep pace in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, but flattened out. LIME RICKEY had the rider's saddle slipped during the early stages, was a bit hard to handle thereafter, exchanging a series of bumps with PLEASANT STRIKE down the backstretch, was guided over to the rail, in an attempt to stay out of harm's way, saved ground during the run around the second bend, then completed the race under his own courage after turning for home.
