Footnotes

LINCOLN PENNY made slight contact with GRANGERARDO out of the gate but grabbed the front right after the break nonetheless, darted over towards the inside, was under a hold setting pedestrian opening splits, had JAZZBO draw alongside departing the backstretch, went head to head with that opponent without the tempo of the event picking up much, was roused entering the stretch, kicked clear during the ensuing furlong and remained so, crossing the finish line under hand encouragement. FU PEGS BABY contently tracked the front runners taking the inside route, was asked for run just prior to vacating the rail at the five-sixteenths pole, got out finished by the winner. STRAIGHT TO IT was put to a good hold attending the pace from the outside, fell back during the run around the bend, altered course outward in upper stretch and staged a mild comeback to be along for the show. GRIFFIN ROCK swung five wide into the stretch while never posing as a threat. JAZZBO four wide leaving the backstretch, was much closer to the rail disputing the pace with the winner around the bend, got shaken off turning for home and tired steadily. KNOCKOUT four wide at the three-eighths pole, was never involved. GRANGERARDO bumped lightly with the top one after leaping at the break, underwent a three wide pursuit, was set down by midpoint on the turn, folded.
