PARAIBA got jostled in the initial stages, bumping with and bouncing between rivals, settled near midpack and rated kindly towards the two path thereafter, picked up the pace gradually swinging outward for the stretch drive, fanned into the six path at the head of the stretch, with only one opponent being wider at that juncture, responded positively after being straightened away, collared the front runners with about a sixteenth remaining and edged away, crossing the wire, hand urged. LOYAL SHADOW unhurried from the outside, commenced her stretch drive placed seven wide at the top of the lane, charged home with good energy to garner place honors. NURSE DOLCE stalked the front runners three wide, issued a challenge as the field headed for the stretch,

finished willingly down the lane but had to settle for the show. CONSIDERATE traded bumps with the top one soon after the start, took up the chase from the two path, ranged up to apply more pressure on the battling pair just up ahead coming to the quarter pole, turned for home and rallied in earnest, grabbed a narrow advantage making her way through the furlong grounds, held it until near the sixteenth pole, weakened slightly in the late stages. MYRTLE'S GRAY came out a step or two at the start, sat on hold in midpack for nearly a half, was already under encouragement spinning from the five path into the stretch, kept up the pressure until the eighth pole before flattening out. UPPER EAST SIDER raced along the outside and improved position. LADY VI urged cutting the corner into the stretch, lacked the needed response. WHO IS LADY exchanged a series of bumps in the opening stages with the eventual winner, raced at or near the inside and tired. KARAKORUM ELEKTRA took the inside route, was under urging throughout the run around the bend, angled outward entering the stretch, backed away. EDEN IS BURNING pressed the issue from three wide, came under heavy pressure by upper stretch and readily succumbed. STRATEGIC MISSILE made light contact with PRINCESS MAURA a few strides away from the gate, argued for command from the rail until the quarter pole, gave way. PRINCESS MAURA bumped lightly with STRATEGIC MISSILE just after the start, was a forward factor from off the inside to the quarter pole, wilted.
