Footnotes

SPRINGCOURT was unhurried from off the inside for the opening six furlongs, got put to solid encouragement and was angled outward to be four wide by the head of the stretch, took off in earnest after the front runners after finishing this maneuver and closed in readily, continued onward with good energy past the eighth pole, going by in the final seventy yards to prove best. WILLY PAY stumbled at the start, bounced back up and moved into midpack, was asked for some run by the five-sixteenths pole, commenced the stretch drive three wide, held his own against the leader during the ensuing furlong, cut into that one's lead thereafter, had no answer for the winner once that opponent arrived on the scene but finished willingly to procure the place. DON'T EVER GIVE UP vied for command from the three path, issued a successful challenge late on the turn and had no sooner taken over when the runner up issued a challenge of his own, dug in well before yielding and weakening in the closing stages. DOUBLESPEAK displayed little speed leaving the starting gate and quickly tucked along the rail, contently trailed the field during the initial stages, picked up interest during the later stages of the run around the bend, swung five wide into upper stretch and mustered up enough of a kick to grab the last major check. SPIELBERG placed six wide at the head of the stretch, mainly improved position. JUNIOR OFFICER three wide and under a long drive on the turn, tired. COPPER TIGER raced from off the inside, was put to a drive

angling outward from the five-sixteenths pole, flattened out. CAT SWEEP departed the backstretch from the three path, was hard used on the turn and gave way. MONEY IN MOTION four wide at the midway point on the bend, folded. RUTHERFORD B. under urging arguing to maintain command from the two path, started backing away shortly before going three-quarters. EL CUADRO saved ground, was asked for some run by the three-eighths pole, faded.
