Footnotes

OUR ENTOURAGE tracked the pace along the inside unhurried, had a seam develop straightening for home between TWILIGHT ECLIPSE and SPEIGHTSCITY when put to encouragement, split those rivals at the three-sixteenths, seized command a furlong out, fought on to the finish with a pair digging in to repulse the late challenge, drifted out in the final steps to the wire despite off sided stick work to keep a straight course. CALLED TO SERVE well held between foes off heels in close range of the front, tried to shift out from in behind rivals at the nine-sixteenths but was unable due to the presence of BIG CREEK, attempted it a second time at the three-eighths successfully to maneuver into the three path at that juncture for a clear path, remained on hold until set down nearing the three-sixteenths, was the outermost of a trio within a length a furlong out battling it out to the finish, rallied with good energy on the outside and just missed. TWILIGHT ECLIPSE attended the pace from the three path well rated, got set down at the quarter pole, battled heads apart through until the final sixteenth when slightly out kicked between foes late on, was forced to be taken in hand near the finish as the eventual winner drifted in the final strides while well clear for the show honors. SPEIGHTSCITY reserved on the pace just off the inside, got let out cutting the corner for home, yielded the front readily soon after straightening away and came up empty. BIG CREEK three wide just off the pace at the rear of a compact field, came under urging at the five-sixteenths and offered no serious response.
