Footnotes

WHY ARGUE engaged in a tussle with STONE PICKER, went at it head to head with that opponent, lightly coaxed and in sharp contrast with his much energetically-handled nemesis, turned for home and got called upon himself, poked a head down in front by the end of the furlong grounds, wasn't able to shake free, remained on nearly even terms until just past the sixteenth pole, then got hooked up for a second time in a lively battle, this time with the runner up, dug in stubbornly to preserve a narrow advantage. REGGIE D drifted out a bit while amongst rivals early down the backstretch, resulting in an exchange of light bumps with HE'S R' DEHERE NOW, entered the turn from off the inside, was three wide and set down slightly more than halfway around the bend, turned for home and closed in on the duelers, raced as a team with little separating him with the winner for much of the final sixteenth, got denied and had to settle for the place. STONE PICKER underwent a series of light bumps at the start, wasn't severely affected by any of it and assumed a forward position, took up position in the two path and sparred with the eventual winner, getting asked for more and more as he sped around the turn until set down to a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, lost the advantage making his way from upper to mid lane, but by only a sliver, refused to back down, putting up a good fight for another sixteenth before finally weakening into the show slot. CRUSHIN ROCK bumped several times at the start, was guided over to the rail after WHO vacated the premises, launched a mild move from upper stretch to narrow in, flattened out. WHO got gently bounced between rivals a few times at the start, tucked along the inside and rode the rail until the three-eighths pole, tired steadily after entering the stretch. RAFFIE'S STAR saved ground and was no

factor. KEYALY swung five wide into the stretch and made no impact. RIVER RON raced from well off the inside on the turn and into the stretch, and tired. HE'S R' DEHERE NOW behaved greenly after getting jostled early down the backstretch, raced along the outside and was outrun thereafter. MAXIECLIPSKY displayed brief foot.
