LEAPING LADY prompting the runner up from the outside, doing so from the two path under light coaxing, was called for more and challenged in earnest as the front twosome spun into the stretch, drove past BRIDGETTA to take charge by the eighth pole, drew clear, driving. BRIDGETTA quickly grabbed the early advantage, cut the pace from the inside, rated until the quarter pole, came under intensified pressure at that station and was let out in response, yielded to the winner nonetheless, held on well thereafter to secure second. SO FASHION bumped WHY TAKE A CHANCE's hind quarters then was checked a couple of jumps out of the starting gate, lost momentum and dropped back considerably, worked her way back towards the pack from the outside on the turn, ducked over to the rail approaching the quarter pole and cut the corner into the stretch, made no additional headway on the top twosome after leaving the furlong marker. CAPABLE ARGUMENT raced along the outside off the front runners, tired after going a half. WHY TAKE A CHANCE lightly bumped just out of the starting gate, underwent a three wide pursuit and gave way. CASTLES BURNING saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole, was no factor.
