SANDYINTHESUN three wide towards the rear initially, progressed from the seven-sixteenths under coaxing, spun into the lane from the two path, angled out one path near the eighth pole, split rivals in the late stages to get up on the wire and prevail. SLEEPY FREUD just off the pace just off the inside, cut the corner roused into the lane, took command just past the eighth pole, kicked home with good energy but was outfinished on the line. ANAPHYLAXIS towards the rear just off the inside, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun six wide in upper stretch, drifted in through the stretch under off sided stick work, making light contact a furlong out with HOPE STILL SPRINGS all the while kicking on with good energy and just missed. POWERFUL INSTINCT four deep towards the rear, improved position while three to four wide through the turn, came under urging at he five-sixteenths, rallied, but was outkicked through the latter stages while safely garnering the last major share. OWEN RICO vied while two to three wide in reserve on the front, came under light coaxing as his main pace rival retreated at the three-eighths pole, got set down spinning for home, was displaced just past the eighth pole and weakened late on. IN MY EYES settled in midpack saving ground, got set down at the five-sixteenths, swung five wide for home and made no impact. MR COWBOY three deep just

off the pace, was placed to coaxing at the five-sixteenths and weakened in the final eighth. HOPE STILL SPRINGS leapt at the start nearly catapulting the rider and conceding four lengths to the front, tracked inside from towards the rear, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, swung five wide for home, shied away midstretch as ANAPHYLAXIS drifted in, then bumped with AMERICAN BUFFALO, offered no kick through the final furlong. AMERICAN BUFFALO four deep midpack, got let out at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home, was bumped by HOPE STILL SPRINGS just past the eighth pole as that one shied from ANAPHYLAXIS, and weakened thereafter. ROARING CONQUEST four wide in close range initially, shifted in one path as the closest pursuer when BAKE SHOP retreated at the three-eighths pole, was in among tight quarters coming to the quarter pole when forced to be taken in hand lightly and briefly tiring as rivals took over his lane. BAKE SHOP vied inside showing brief speed for a half and gave way.
