RUFF was rated along inside, saved ground into the stretch, angled out for running room in upper stretch, responded when roused and drew clear, driving. MYSTIC LADY raced close up inside while well in hand, split rivals in midstretch and finished gamely. MEDICINE BOW was rated outside, put in a three wide run on the second turn and weakened in the final furlong. DAISY DUKES argued the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. FIDDLE was steadied along the inside on the first turn, raced between rivals on the second turn and had no rally. WEST SIDE MARIA was rated along early, put in a three wide run on the second turn and had nothing left for the stretch drive. DREAM WISH argued the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. KILLISTOS was rated outside, put in a four wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch.
