CHESTORIA was rated along inside, advanced inside on the second turn, swung wide into the stretch, quickly showed in front and was clear at the finish, driving. MYSTIC SOUL was outrun early, rallied inside on the second turn, angled out in the stretch and finished well. CHRISTMAS KID raced in hand early, put in a run along the inside on the second turn and weakened in the final furlong. LIMONCELLA raced in hand early, put in a three wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. REAL PROPERTY was outrun early, put in a wide run on the second turn and faded in the drive. BRUSHED GOLD was unhurried early on and had no response when roused. STORM DIXIE was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. TREMENDOUS ONE tired. A WONDER SHE IS raced inside and tired. SHARP SUSAN ran off to a long lead after being compromised by broken equipment then tired.
