WHO'S THE COWBOY unsettled for the break, spotted the field several lengths after the gate was sprung open, rejoined the pack without need of much encouragement, advanced into contention from the outside on the turn, while still not being asked for much run, was given some encouragement after spinning into the lane, split rivals just past the three-sixteenths pole, took over and edged clear under a light drive. NEW MEMBER took control after the start, showed the way towards the two path, facing only mild pressure from the closest pursuer, responded positively when given his cue in upper stretch, proved unable to resist the top one, but held well enough to preserve the place. BRECCIATE was taken over to the inside for the run around the bend, remained on hold until the quarter pole, entered the lane with clear passage along the inside, but was either unable or unwilling to avail of the situation, eventually weakening into the show slot. LOFTY BANNER came five into the lane and had no solid stretch response. RISES THE PHOENIX raced three wide and had no rally. THE ROUNDHOUSE away well from the gate, dropped back to the rear of the pack, lagged behind, well off the inside, and constantly tugging on the left side of the bit, drifted six wide into the stretch, and flashed a mild rally under encouragement. J J'S PROPHET stalked the leader three wide and gave way.
