NEWFOUND DESERT away alertly from the starting gate, was guided over to the inside once sufficiently clear, was rated while setting the pace, responded well when asked for a response entering the stretch, drifted out steadily throughout the stretch run, stubbornly resisting the right handed tactics being applied by the rider, eventually carrying out the runner up several paths nearing the wire to preserve the decision. HEY BABE was unhurried while taking the inside route, found room leaving the five-sixteenths pole to angle outward in preparation for the stretch drive, took off in earnest after being called upon, altered course outward a bit more coming to the eighth pole, continued onward, was gaining good ground on the winner, when carried out several paths by that one in deep stretch. TIGER WILLIE saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole, swung wide into the lane, commenced to rally from the five path at head of the stretch and closed with a strong kick down the outside of the course to garner the show. SCORPER chased three wide, was put to encouragement coming to the five-sixteenths pole, but got outkicked during the final furlong. CORONATION DAY forwardly placed three wide, lacked the necessary stretch response. THOU SWELL urged tracking the leader from the inside, faltered. ELUSIVE FOX attended the pacesetter from the outside until upper stretch and folded. MEL'S GOLD had a wide journey and was outrun. KIJO positioned four wide at the half mile pole, gave way.
