PRECIOUS METAL assumed a forward position after the start, sat perched from the three path for nearly three-quarters, bid in earnest as the field headed into the lane, emerged from the furlong grounds in possession of a clear advantage, edged away under a hard drive. FORTISSI MORE forward placed while between rivals, rallied willingly to grab second. OBVIOUSLY TUESDAY vied for command from the two path with the rider holding something in reserve until the quarter pole, got out finished. LIVING RIGHT unhurried for the opening six furlongs, swung six wide into upper stretch, got straightened away and went on to secure the final major slice. GAMBLIN FEVER raced three wide for most of the way around the second turn, spun five wide for the stretch drive, displayed a mild kick. BUD WHITE well placed stalking the front runners, failed to fire when called upon. SOUND OF DRUMS had a three wide journey, lacked the necessary stretch response. ROCKY WORLD saved ground to no avail. FAST GRIEVANCE rated off the inside for the initial stages, tired. ATITLAN underwent a three wide journey and folded. SKIPS PROSPECT was through after completing three-quarters. ARTIE LUVSTO PARTY argued for command while saving journey, came under heavy pressure approaching the quarter pole and wilted.
