NIGHT MANEUVER broke in a step but was grabbed hold and pulled off the nearest opponent before any contact could be made, sparred from along the inside with his stablemate, with neither pilot asking his mount for speed, continued along on the same scenario until the three-sixteenths pole, opened up a clear advantage almost in a flash when let out at that station, then fended off the runner up trying to scurry by along the rail to preserve the decision. JAW CRUSHER took the inside route, was under encouragement cutting the corner into the stretch, maintained the momentum hugging the rail down the lane as well en route for the place. THE PRIZE FIGHTER vied with his stablemate from the two path, matched the firm hold on the reins being applied by the rider of that one, got called upon in upper stretch but could not keep pace, getting out finished for place honors as well. WESTERN TRYST placed under a snug

hold at the start, moved up willingly to take up residence in the pocket, was let out a notch early on the turn to maintain a good striking position behind the front runners, was under much stringer rousing by the later stages of the run around the bend, tired steadily during the stretch drive. TUG OF WAR stumbled at the start, went on to take the overland route around the turn to no avail. FRENCH WINE gave chase three wide, was put to a prolonged drive and tired. SWAG DADDY off the inside, was coaxed along on the turn to keep pace, gave way. IN TOE'S MEMORY placed near the overland route on the turn, failed to reach contention. GANADOR stumbled at the start, saved ground throughout. FOX RULES was never in contention. BAY PARK BOY raced along the outside and was through after completing a half. GOODTIME BOY five wide into the lane, had no rally. SILENT THUNDER four wide departing the backstretch, tired.
