COURT OF DREAMS came awkwardly out of the starting gate, appeared to take a bad step and bobbled near the five-eighths pole while proceeding down the backstretch, was steadied off another's heels at the nine-sixteenths pole, got taken hold of momentarily during the early stages of the run around the bend, advanced readily when asked for some run from the five-sixteenths pole, paused before splitting rivals making a challenge for command as the field headed into the stretch, with the pilot reapplying a good hold on the reins, was asked for a response about a sixteenth down the road and drew clear from there, crossing the wire hand urged. DESERT BLISS contently tracked the front runners, ignoring an inviting opening along the inside all the while, made her move along that previously described rail passageway approaching the quarter pole, proved no match for the winner en route for place honors. STRIKE ACCORD between rivals, got out finished. DREAMING OF CARA raced along the outside, was already under encouragement spinning into the lane, angled outward for better racing room and rallied to earn the last major slice of the pot. OCALA'S QUEEN saved ground and lacked the needed response. HYPNOTIC DANCER the widest of all during the opening three-quarters, tired. RAFFIE'S CHANCE three wide on the turn, had no rally. TINA'S NOTE snugly rated in the two path, faltered after entering the stretch. SILVER PRIZE was through after going six furlongs. GRAND SAVANNA underwent a three to four wide journey and folded. PRIMED FOR SUCCESS saved ground until the quarter pole.
