BAD ACTION reserved while four wide on the turn, ranged up to the leader when ready, took charge approaching the head of the stretch, drew off to a lengthy advantage when asked for a response, then increased his winning margin while being kept under active handling. LOFTY BANNER saved ground, was taken to the far outside turning for home, finished willingly to secure the place in the late stages. FISHERTHEFIRECHIEF underwent a three wide, bested the rest for the show. TRIPLE GLORY stumbled after being bumped at the start, was slow to settle into stride, moved willingly after being put to encouragement during the run around the bend, ducked back to the rail at the three-sixteenths pole and displayed some interest. SUMMIT CREEK made a quick bid for the lead, opened up a sizeable advantage but had nothing left to offer after going a half. AIN'T NO STAR bumped at the start, failed to reach a contending position. BORDER DISORDER was no menace. TOWNIE'S DREAM faded badly after going a half.
