GENERAL MAXIMUS away in good order, prompted the leader travelling in the three path, patiently bided his time during most of the run around the bend, moved up, with the rider still applying a good hold, nearing the five-sixteenths pole, reached even terms by the quarter pole, was set down after settling into the lane, edged clear during the ensuing furlong, came inward a bit from right handed pressure just past the eighth pole, was put on a truer course in short order, and held sway, while being kept busy to the finish line. BE BULLISH broke running, angled sharply towards the rail soon after leaving the gate, showed the way placed near the two path, facing some pressure from the top one all the while, came under assault from that rival in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, had the lead dwindle down to a precious head advantage turning for home, offered resistance before yielding in upper stretch, but battled onward, altered course at the sixteenth pole for one final try, but had to settle for place honors. RAYNICK'S JET reserved along the outside for nearly a half, was set down coming to the three-sixteenths pole and rallied with good energy for the show. DRIVEN BY SUCCESS spotted the field a four length advantage after throwing his head downward, split seconds before the field was sent off and running, was allowed to settle into stride, rejoining the pack by the half mile pole, attempting to circle his way to contention taking the overland route on the turn, but wasn't up to the task. HEAVENLY BLAZE angled four wide into the stretch and improved position with a mild rally. ENDLESS CIRCLE four wide for most of the way on the turn, gave way. ROLLERS saved ground and failed to menace.
