INNER TURF FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD FOALED IN NEW YORK STATE AND APPROVED BY THE NEW YORK STATE-BRED REGISTRY. No nomination fee. A supplemental nomination fee of \$1,000 may be paid at time of entry. \$600 to pass the entry box and an additional \$650 to start. All starters including supplements are required to pay both entry and starting fees. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Three year olds, 120 lbs. Older, 123 lbs. Turf weights: Non-winners of \$60,000 on the turf in 2010 allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstake on the turf in 2010, 4 lbs.; three races on the turf, 6 lbs. Dirt weights: Non-winners of a sweepstake on the dirt in 2009-10 allowed 3 lbs.; \$30,000 on the dirt in 2009-10 or four races on the dirt 5 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. Closed Saturday, October 9, 2010 with 33 Nominations. (S)

POCKET COWBOYS chased the front runners from the outside, swung four wide into the lane, just gearing up for the stretch run, responded well when given his cue, closed in relentlessly, wore down STRAIGHT STORY in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and edged clear under steady right handed encouragement. STRAIGHT STORY shot out of the gate to grab an instant lead, was rated well off the inside most of the way while cutting the early fractions, came under encouragement entering the stretch, yielded with about a sixteenth to go, but continued on with good courage to preserve place honors. KUTAIS put on a prolonged drive, rallied with interest to be along for the show. UNCLE T SEVEN swung three wide into the lane, was called upon and displayed a mild kick to grab the last major share. MR. VEGAS was off sluggishly, after hitting the right side of the gate at the break, was maneuvered over to rail in plenty of time for the run around the opening bend, lagged behind in the back of the pack for most of the running, before improving position past mainly tired and weak ones during the stretch drive. SPA CITY FEVER raced along the outside, was urged on the turn, flattened out during the last eighth. PIAZZA DI SPAGNA saved ground and failed to menace. MIDNIGHT BILLY accompanied the pacesetter until midstretch and gave way. GOOD PROSPECT retreated after going five furlongs. PRETTY BOY FREUD was through after going six furlongs.
