### Footnotes

CRIBNOTE broke well maneuvering into the three path when able, got coaxed along through the first half while tracking the duel up front three wide around the turn, had the rider spirit him up nearing the head of the lane and readily responded down the lane, collared the leader just past the sixteenth pole while the rider kept busy to the wire. GROUND FORCE dueled in reserve while just to the outside his speedy rival on the rail, took over still under restraint at the halfway point, came under a ride nearing the quarter pole and responded well, dug in when the aforementioned rival arrived on the scene at the eighth pole and fought well through the furlong grounds to just be caught late. LITIGATE three to four wide around the turn came under a drive by midway on the turn and steadily gained, swung four wide into the lane and rallied readily for the show. CAPITOL HOOK dueled inside under light coaxing, saved ground throughout, stayed on well until the final eighth and steadily tired. ABLE BELLAMY was jostled between rivals at the start when GROUND FORCE came in slightly at the break, settled three wide most of the way while being lightly coaxed along in midpack, finished evenly through the stretch. RIZZI'S COMET broke sharply and was taken back soon after the start, settled towards the rear while in reserve, had the rider encourage him to pick up the pace near the five-sixteenths, displayed a mild bid passed tiring rivals. AMBASSADOR BRIDGE settled towards the rear, came under a prolonged drive, made some progress on the front until the eighth pole and tired. FORTITUDE saved ground throughout while coaxed along in midpack, offered little. HYSTERICAL CAT four wide throughout, came under a long drive and was outrun.
