HISTORY STARTS NOW took the two path around the turn, maneuvered through an opening while roused at the quarter pole, was between rivals at the three-sixteenths briefly before assuming command, edged clear in the final furlong being kept busy to the end. DIGGER KARAKORUM tracked three wide throughout, was spirited up near the quarter pole and displayed a mild bid to be second best. LEAP DAY hustled from the gate, set the pace inside, felt the top one's pressure nearing the quarter pole, was put to a drive straightening for home, succumbed at the three-sixteenths, held well for third. POWER KING four wide throughout, made a mild bid coming to the head of the lane, secured the last major share while never threatening the front. FRENCH TRANSITION three wide around the turn, came under a drive midway, made steady progress through the furlong grounds while never a menace. FREGATA hustled midway on the turn offered no response. EX PAT tossed his head early fighting restraint just after the start, settled in the two path for the run around the bend, had no offering. BINDLE STICK took the overland route in the turn and was never in contention. WADI SUKI saved ground throughout, was mildly coaxed at the top of the lane, displayed no kick then was pulled up quickly after the finish.
