C C'S PAL left the backstretch forwardly placed, sat perched from the three path under a good hold from the rider during the run around the bend, was put to encouragement and issued a challenge for command the widest of a threesome as the field headed into lane, continued the stirring dispute down the lead, grabbed the lead for good in deep stretch and edged away under good handling. ALSEERA broke outward but was grabbed hold and pulled off the nearest opponent before contact could be made, argued for control with another pair leaving the half mile pole, positioned slightly off the rail, came under intensified pressure approaching the quarter pole and was let out in response, came out a bit after settling into upper stretch, leaving an inviting space along the rail for an eager CATCH A THIEF, was forced to preserve a narrow advantage from between rivals, gradually drifted back towards the inside making her way to the eighth pole and beyond, squeezing the aforementioned back in the process, yielded reluctantly late and had to settle for the place. BELLE OF THE HALL was guided to the inside near the half mile pole, rode the rail until just before reaching the half mile pole, made a sharp five angle into the lane and displayed a good kick down the center of the strip to grab the show. CATCH A THIEF tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, turned for home with enough passage awaiting her along the rail and launched a run that transformed her into a bold threat with an eighth to go, got incrementally squeezed back as the hole was resealed during the next sixteenth pole, was taken in hand and failed to regain interest. KID KATE unhurried of the inside, was already under encouragement spinning four wide for the stretch run, lacked the needed response. INDIAN BURN raced along the outside, was asked to pick up the pace in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, came up empty. COAX LIBERTY well placed stalking the pacesetter from between rivals, tired.
