STRIKE ACCORD contently tracked the pacesetter from the pocket until the quarter pole, had already been put to brisk hand encouragement a sixteenth up the road before getting angled outward for the drive home, made steady progress from upper to midstretch, gained real estate more readily to be on nearly even terms in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, took over and kicked away. TAKE IT INSIDE bumped at the start with CHLOE BEAR, didn't let that incident prevent her from taking control before reaching the head of the backstretch, set the splits being rated on an open lead, pilot applying only mild hand urging, arrived at the end of the far turn facing intensified pressure and was let out in response, held out on the front until about a sixteenth remaining, held out well enough thereafter to secure second. MIZ OWELL strung out three to four wide on the opening bend, was almost as wide on the subsequent one, lacked the needed response to keep pace with the top twosome, while staying well clear of the others for show honors. FLIRTATIOUS SPRING between rivals on the second bend, had no rally. GOLDEN CHEETAH off to a sluggish beginning, saved ground for just over six furlong, lacked the needed stretch response. KATE IS A TEN three wide on each bend, failed to menace. CHLOE BEAR made contact with the runner up at the start, raced three wide on both turns, folded. HOPE FOR TOMORROW reserved in the two path for the initial three-quarters, got roused while angling out into the four path leaving the five-sixteenths pole, made no headway.
